Students of Years 9 and 10 have been offered a great opportunity to participate in Shire wide 'Connected' workshops led by "Just Motivation". They will be joining students from other schools within the Warrumbungle Shire in activities focused on encouraging students to recognise connection and communication beyond surface level interactions.

The project is a fast-track restorative program for students in relationship building, resilience and recovery. Many students have missed out on critical development opportunities like excursions, leaving many young people feeling socially isolated and with few meaningful connections. It is these meaningful connections and friendships which equip our youth with the ability to recover from adverse events, and give them the confidence to reach out to their community for support.
