The Task:

Choose **ONE** Lost City from the list below in the format of a PowerPoint Presentation

List of Cities: Petra, Babylon, Pompeii, Atlantis, Angkor Wat & Machu Picchu or another of your choosing.

The following questions might help guide your inquiry:

- **Where is the city located and when did people live there?**
- **What is the cultural significance of the city?**
- **What influence from other cultures existed in the city?**
- **What does trade tell you about the interaction between other civilisations?**
- **What do the sources tell us about the people that lived there?**

Your presentation should:

- Be between 5-8 mins in length
- Include Primary and Secondary sources
- Include visual elements and a bibliography

You will be given some time in class to plan your presentation, however, it is expected that you will work on this project in your own time.

Submission:

This is a compulsory assessment task. Tasks should be submitted in digital or hardcopy format at 9am on the specified due date. Presentations will proceed in class in a random order. **Late submission** will attract a penalty of 10% per day for the first five days. **Failure to submit** the task prior to the due date may result in communication with parents/carers, lunchtime detentions, and other academic penalty. **Plagiarism**, the unauthorised and/or unacknowledged use of other's work, can amount to serious academic misconduct and can result in communications with parents/carers, requirement of resubmission, and other academic penalty.
