Task description:

Composition (10 marks)

You are to compose a persuasive, discursive or imaginative text. Your text must:

- a) Begin with a quote from a Mod C prescribed text
- b) Explore a theme, idea or character from a Mod C prescribed text
- c) Use a language or structural feature modelled in a Mod C prescribed text
- ** You do not have to use the same Mod C prescribed text for all these elements
- ** Your piece should be about 800 words

Reflection (10 marks)

Evaluate how your study of figurative language in The Craft of Writing influenced the creative decisions you made in part (A). In your response make reference to at least ONE of your Module C prescribed texts. (10 marks)

** Your reflection should be about 500 – 600 words
