## STAND TALL (TAMWORTH) EXCURSION FRIDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2023

We are excited to advise that we have the opportunity to take students to a fantastic event for young people to be held in Tamworth on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2023.

Stand Tall (which is now in its 11<sup>th</sup> year), brings a host of high-quality speakers together on the one day with the aim of growing children's resilience and strength and giving them the power and perspective to make positive life choices. Much of the content covered will align to the PDHPE syllabus. More information about the day can be found online at standtallevent.com/regional tour.

We are most fortunate that the organisers of the event have obtained a government grant which will cover our transport costs. The admission price is \$1 per student and the school is covering that cost.

Our hope is that all students in Years 9,10 and Year 12 will attend. Normal class will not run on that day but if students attend school there will be supervised learning activities.

Additionally, Stand Tall are seeking your permission to survey your son or daughter, further details as follows:

#### STAND TALL X HUBER SOCIAL SURVEY

Stand tall has partnered with social impact measurement experts Huber Social to measure the impact of Stand tall. To do this, they are asking young people who are coming to Stand Tall to complete a short survey. This will take place during Stand Tall. Your child's answers will be anonymous, and their participation is voluntary. Your child can skip any question that they don't want to answer and can stop the survey at any time. The survey asks young people questions about their wellbeing including resilience, wellness and other areas. You can find more details and see the survey yourself at hubersocial.com.au/StandTall.

All reporting will be conducted at a group level- your child's individual results will never be shared. Results will be used to inform a report on the impact of Stand Tall and help improve future events. Your child's de-identified data will be stored securely in the Huber Social Wellbeing Database and may be used to help understand the wellbeing needs of young people in the future.
