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Task:

You will be required to also submit an **individual written response** on the same day you submit your poster that addresses a question/s provided to you by your teacher.

NOTE: This is a *compulsory* assessment task. A 10% penalty applies for each day the task is submitted late without explanation. Students requiring one must arrange an extension with the Head Teacher within TWO school days of the due date. A student absent due to illness or misadventure from a task or the day a task is due must provide a valid explanation to cover the absence. Failure to submit this assessment task may jeopardise your ability to attain a ROSA.

Task in Detail

Part A)

In groups, you are to create a visual poster that represents a key theme or event of World War II.

The following list includes some ideas for key themes and events. You must check with your teacher before choosing your option.

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Your poster should include 5 key elements:

- ✓ Written information
- ✓ Primary Sources of Evidence
- ✓ Secondary Sources of Evidence
- ✓ Images/Photos
- ✓ A Creative Element

Your poster will be combined with the other Year 10 classes to make a collaborative Theme Board to be displayed in the school.

Your teacher will approve the group you work in. You must submit your poster on the due date regardless of whether another person in your group is absent.

Part B)

You will be required to submit an individual written response on the same day you submit your poster that addresses a question provided to you by your teacher.

This response will take the form of either short answer questions, an extended response question or an essay.

You will be given some class time to complete this task but it will also be necessary for you to work on this task in your own time.

It is expected in Year 10 that you will include a **complete bibliography** for all research materials you have used. Failure to include a bibliography to HSIE standards will result in your work being treated as unsatisfactory and may require resubmission.
